## Introduction

-The Five Solas

Essentially, a former Augustinian monk named Martin Luther and his contemporaries started a protest against the unbiblical actions and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church in Europe, which launched the Protestant Reformation.

At the heart of the 16th-century movement was the question of ultimate authority in the Christian Church and the life of the Christian. The Protestant Reformation was a call back to biblical Christianity, to acknowledge that the authority on all matters, both for the Church and believers, is God's Word alone and that sinful man is reconciled with God by faith in Christ alone.

Protestantism rejects core claims of the Catholic Church, including apostolic succession, the infallibility attributed to the pope, and the equating of the authority of church teaching and tradition with the authority of Scripture. Out of the Reformation emerged the articulation of five essential points of doctrine known as the five solas. These five statements serve as a summary of the core beliefs that separate Protestantism from Roman Catholicism. (learning how to disagree without being disagreeable!)

- 1. Grace Alone
- 2. Faith Alone
- 3. Christ Alone
- 4. Scripture Alone
- 5. The Glory of God Alone

## By Grace alone

-<mark>Grace means that God gives us what we don't deserve and could never</mark> possibly earn, unmerited favor.
