The Church in America

-In 2006 a group called Mosaix set out with the goal of seeing 20% of churches in America reach 20 percent racial diversity by the year of 2020...and in 2020 when they released their data, that goal had been realized.

- But was this "on purpose" (question we ask our kids)
- How many became diverse because their context did?
- How many became diverse because of "white flight?"
- % of black people attending mc churches 27% in 2012.

• After 2020 that number dropped to 21%.

But I wasn't buying it. Having studied multiracial churches, I knew he was in for a rude awakening. I shared some of what I discuss in my book The Elusive Dream: The Power of Race in Interracial Churches: Multiracial churches tend to mimic white churches in their culture and theology; whites are not comfortable with black church culture or addressing the elephant in the room, race; multiracial churches work—that is, remain diverse—to the extent that their white members are comfortable. – Korie Little Edwards

-So what do I say about the glaring correlation between the rise in multi-cultural church and the steep decline in church affiliation over the exact same period?

-I believe churches in America are in decline even while the diversity of congregations are on the rise because people who are coming to churches in search of a Gospel message that promises reconciliation are finding churches preaching a cross that reconciles us to God but is simultaneously failing miserably at being reconciled to one another...simply put, we lack a credible witness!

 - The mystery is NOT reconciled to God
 - The mystery IS reconciled to one another
 - Chapter 4 unity in the church

 - Devil knows the credibility of our message cannot be overcome...so the next best option is to destroy the credibility of our witness!

 - -What if it's my atrophied will that won't move toward my brother and sister in Christ who is in need...
 - -What if it's my loving, calming presence that's supposed to calm the storms of life that are causing others to despair...
 - -What if...what if it's the miracle of reconciling relationships that feel irreconcilable!!!!!!!!
