The Place...?

<mark>-Joshua 13:14</mark>

-How many tribes...Where is Joseph...Who else is missing...Where did they live, how were they sustained? (talk too about them being a living sacrifice)

It was understood that the nation of Israel would collectively support the work of the ministry as well as those tasked with doing that ministry.

At the inception of the Church in Acts, we find a continuation of a commitment to the collective financial support of the ministry of their home church...our baseline giving should start with the church we call home.

The Offerings...?

-Proverbs 28:27 (poor)

-Leviticus 19:9-10 (hospitality)

-Exodus 36:3-7 (projects)

-Romans 15:25-26 (missions)

I believe 10% of our gross earnings is the starting point of our personal stewardship giving strategy, given to the church we call home, supplemented by gifts to the poor, hospitality, special projects, and missions.

-2 Kings 4:1-7
