## Praxis 9 Internship Code of Conduct

- 1. I understand that by enrolling as a student of City Life Church's Praxis 9 Internship, I am accepting all policies established by the Praxis 9 Leadership Team.
- 2. I understand that communication and interaction between parents, interns, mentors, teachers and administration is encouraged. Communication should be carried on in a constructive and Biblical manner.
- 3. I shall refrain from the following destructive behaviors regarding the use of my words:
  - i. Gossiping (repeating information about others that is not my concern or not edifying, whether true or untrue)
  - ii. Slander (repeating information about others that is untrue)
  - iii. Mockery (disdainful or disrespectful talk about those in authority, the church, or scriptural principles)
  - iv. Profanity, Obscenity, Vulgarity, and/or Offensive Slang
- 4. I shall not lie, cheat, or steal. I am not only expected to adhere to this policy, but also to promote and encourage my peers to do the same.
- 5. I understand that Praxis 9 has a Biblical standard of refraining from any sexual conduct or social behavior that is based on culture, the popular media, or peer groups. I shall govern my behavior to hold to these standards and shall not at any time use or possess any pornography since this is certainly a destroyer of self-discipline, self-control, and definitely against God's plan for Christian people.
- 6. I shall use any and all electronic media (cell phones; cameras; mp3 players; e-mail, internet, and websites, such as Instagram, FB, Snapchat, etc.) in a manner that is constructive and Biblical. I shall make my websites immediately accessible to my Praxis 9 mentor or administration at any time upon their request.
- 7. I will also agree to forgo the use of permissible activities such as the use of tobacco and alcohol for the <u>next 9 months</u> during the Praxis 9 Internship Program.
- 8. I understand that attendance is an essential element of learning and I shall put forth my best effort in regular and timely attendance as well as participating in all trips and scheduled events for Praxis 9 interns. For the next 9 months (Sept- May), the expectation is for me to be available (2) Wednesday nights out of the month, every Thursday & Friday from 6:15pm-8:30pm, Saturday mornings 8am-Noon as well as Saturday Night service from 2pm-7pm.

**Praxis 9 Internship Program Code of Conduct** is established as a means of communicating and understanding the lifestyle standards agreed upon for our interns. Each standard addresses choices that interns are capable of making and acting upon as individuals. The expectations apply to Praxis 9 interns whether the student is on or off church property. *An unwillingness to make one's best effort to meet these standards also implies a choice to not continue as a student at City Life Church's Praxis 9 Internship Program.*
