Recap/Introduction

- -Mark 10:17-27 (make some recap comments)

Holy Spirit baptism is the disruption and reordering of the seats of power and influence in your life. I like to call it a spiritual chiropractic experience whereby the Holy Spirit is repositioned to become the dominant influencer of your will.

- -Holy Spirit Baptism is a personal encounter and is the beginning of a lifetime of moments being filled afresh and anew.

Receive Power

Band

-There is the person whose primary gift to the Body of Christ is a prophetic ministry of declaring a message from God that must be accompanied by an interpretation...this may not be your calling. (1 Corinthians 12:29-30 ref.)

-There are moments when people are compelled by God to be an instrument of His being manifested to the world...this may not happen to you. (1 Corinthians 12:7,11 ref.)

-There is the ability to express ourselves to God in times of prayer and worship unencumbered by human intellect and earthly language...this is for us all. (1 Corinthians 14:18 ref.)
