The Path of Life

Fullness of Joy Forevermore

- -Psalm 16:11 is reminding us that joy is a feeling that over time can become a virtue (Galatians 5:22 Greek cousins is "chairo").
- -Hebrew word is "simchah" (sim-khaw)
 - Mirth, gladness, joy of God, happy
 - Root word: joyful, merry, and glad
 - Origin word: to rejoice, to be glad, to cause to rejoice
 - *>happiness is a feeling that is circumstance dependent*
 - >joy is a feeling that is God dependent
 - >Joyfulness is a virtue based on the character of Christ in you!
- -(talk about making room for lament, grief, sorrow, trauma...)
- -(talk about mental health, brain chemistry...)

Band

- -Joy is happiness with a heavy dose of delight that comes from being in God's presence regardless of my circumstances.
- -Remember...God wants to use your life to spell Jesus to the world and His joy through you is a great start!
