 The Kingdom of Heaven is near... (21st) (Just because the Kingdom of Heaven is near, doesn't mean you don't have to travel far to get there!) -The 3 remarkable journeys...

- Escape to Egypt repent of your sins
- The Maigi the Kingdom of Heaven is near
- Return to Nazareth turn to God

-This series is for everyone, even if Jesus already arrived in your life years before when you made a vow of devotion to Him. All of us have areas of our lives where we are reluctant for Jesus to have full authority...and God says to you and to me: "Prepare The Way!"

Escape to Egypt

-Matthew 2:13-16

- The death of the innocent
- For the salvation of another
- Verses 17 and 18

-These families are heroes in Heaven, not forsaken by God...they carried the weight of this prophetic picture!

-Jesus, the Innocent...died for our own escape!!!!!

-Romans 5:8 & Hebrews 4:15 – ref.

- Jesus is the prophetic picture of mankind!!!
- Israel is...life with God!
- Egypt is...life in bondage to sin!

-The escape of Jesus' family to Egypt illustrates for us the sinfulness of mankind and our need to prepare the way for Jesus in our own hearts by <u>repenting of our sins</u>.

What Is Repentance?

-Luke 17:3 (means person does not benefit from forgiveness until...)

-repentance means... (not just sorrow and regret)

- Acknowledgement
- Confession
- Forgiveness
- Resolve

-John 8:31-32 (NASB)

- Continue: Giving Scripture authority over you.
- Know: Examining your life in light of Scripture.
- Free: Bringing your life in alignment with Scripture.

(Romans 13:8-14 and Romans 14) - ref.

-Is ______ a sin that was time bound?

(Matthew 15:10-11,13) - read and explain "uprooted"

-Is ______ a sin that leads to death?

(1 John 5:17...venial vs. mortal) – ref.

-If you ignore the complexity of something in an effort to simplify truth, you inevitably create the confusion you were trying to avoid.

-Any sin that is ever listed in Scripture with the stated consequence of spiritual death, eternal damnation, or the loss of Heaven as an inheritance...can never be time bound or a matter of conscience.

(<u>1 Corinthians 6:9-10</u>, Galatians 5:19-21, Ephesians 5:3-5)
