-I want to talk to men tonight for a few minutes... (standing right now between your kids and the most candy they will see all year...like standing in front of a stampede and I'm taking my life into my own hands!)

David the Warrior

-1 Samuel 17:1-16 (there is a reason these stories resonate with you)

- David was probably about 16
- had already killed lions and bears
- chores different then/our chore board at home

-You long to be a warrior that slays! You want to be perceived as dangerous.

-movies and shows: Saving Private Ryan, Braveheart, The Avengers, Punisher, Dare Devil, James Bond...The Last of the Mohicans

-Wild At Heart by John Eldredge is a classic!!! (Shift from YOU to WE)

-growing up: John Wayne and Tarzan...

-modern society is civilized: we "slay" through sports, business, high risk hobbies, traveling adventures...we want to conquer!)

-We want to be the "David" that slays the giant!

-Our dream is to be that warrior.

David the Worshipper

-2 Samuel 6:12-19 (David at least 30 here...)

-God's dream is for us to be this warrior...David is a warrior in both settings!

This desire to be a warrior is not left over from a time in history that has passed...sure this desire helped us meet a practical need in society and still does today for some...but this "fight" he has put in us has always been first and foremost about standing against the forces of evil that are at work in this world trying destroy God's great plans to redeem and rescue this world from sin and darkness!

-Ephesians 6:10-12

1.) Integrity...respect your own moral code, honor your moral compass!

2.) Vulnerability...find a small group of men you can trust and stop hiding!

3.) Hostility...unleash your inner warrior...worship, prayer, Bible...the other Pathways should be pursuits for you that you engage with intensity!

(What if someone right now started to physically assault your family...would you say, "Well, my personality doesn't lend itself to...")
