-Holy Roar is a study of 7 Hebrew words that all translate as “praise” in our English Bibles. (Jewish people saw these actual words!)

- 1. Yadah – the hands of praise**
- 2. Halal – the celebration of praise**
- 3. Zamar – the music of praise**
- 4. Towdah – the expectation of praise**
- 5. Barak – the posture of praise**
- 6. Tehillah – the song of praise**
- 7. Shabach – the shout of praise**

## The Music of Praise

### **-Zamar**

**>to make music, to celebrate in song and music, to touch the strings or parts of a musical instrument**

**>Psalm 144:9**

>Psalm 7:17

### **-Tehillah**

**>laudation, a hymn, a song of praise, a new song, a spontaneous song.**

**>Psalm 100:4**

>Psalm 145:21

>Psalms in Hebrew is the Tehillum.

## Ready or Not

-John 2:1-5

-(talk about Jesus having had a plan...until his Mom thought differently!)

**-There are times in our lives when the Holy Spirit waits for us and then there are times when He ignores our objections and thrusts us into experiences where it is hard for us to say no...because He always has our best interest at heart!**

-(tell story of first missions trip and song after dinner that night)
