Introduction

-Holy Roar is a study of 7 Hebrew words that all translate as “praise” in our English Bibles. (Jewish people saw these actual words!)

- 1. Yadah - the hands of praise**
- 2. Halal - the celebration of praise**
- 3. Zamar - the music of praise**
- 4. Towdah - the expectation of praise**
- 5. Barak - the posture of praise**
- 6. Tehilla - the song of praise**
- 7. Shabach - the shout of praise**

When I Praise

-I am an eternal, immortal being created by God to live and rule and reign with Him forever!

-This means many things but most importantly, it means that your greatest need is to know God and to be known by Him!

-Matthew 22:34-40 (not just a commandment...a promise!)

-Acts of expression lead to feelings of intimacy so when I praise, feelings of love toward God grow in me and feelings of being loved by God grow in me!

-Who are the people you love most in life and those you feel loved by most in life? (participation moment)

- *Confide in one another*
- *Transparent with one another*
- *Share dreams with one another*
- *Share laments with one another*
- *Expressions of affection for one another*
- *Celebrate one another*
- *Initiate conversations with one another*
- *Describe attributes about one another*

-Praise is not a religious tradition; praise is a relational treasure!

When I Posture

-Acts of expression lead to feelings of intimacy AND physical posturing emphasizes the sentiment AND amplifies the feelings!

-(have Michael come forward)

-Acts of expression lead to feelings of intimacy so when I praise, feelings of love toward God grow in me and feelings of being loved by God grow in me! Physical posturing emphasizes the sentiment being expressed AND amplifies the feelings of love growing in me.

-Yadah

>To revere or worship with extended hands. To hold out the hands.
To throw a stone or arrow.

>To kneel. To bless God (as an act of adoration). To praise. To salute.
To thank.

> **Psalm 100:4**
