This Series

-Are you at peace with God, yourself, others, and creation?

-The two texts we'll be using that give us our subtitle: Peace With Your Portion

- Matthew 25:14-19 (God, yourself, others, and creation)
- Genesis 1:1-31 (God, yourself, others, and creation)
- 1. embrace His sovereignty. (Jesus did...)
- 2. embrace your unchangeables (Jesus did...)
- 3. embrace their diversity (Jesus did...)
- 4. embrace your chores (Jesus did...)

-You will never be at peace with yourself until you are ready to embrace your portion of unchangeables.

Unchangeables

-Matthew 25:14-30

- note: false narratives about God don't justify rebellion
- The Master gave each servant a different portion.
- The Portions were not negotiable.
- The Servants were accountable for tasks they didn't choose.
- The bags of silver are a prophetic picture of unchangeables

-What are the unchangeables of your life? (participation)

- time in history
- family of origin
- ethnicity
- personality
- spiritual gifts
- natural abilities
- my comparative experience
- intellectual capacity
- fertility
- providence
- time
- physical death
- body shape and size
- genetic conditions

- sex, gender, and sexuality (talk about idolatry...the created being the creator, each of these individual but NOT independent!)
- -1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, 23a...I think Paul here is telling us something about Shalom.

-Are you willing to be thankful for every "portion" The Master has assigned to you?

The Genesis Lens

-Genesis 1:1-31

- there is <u>purpose</u> in everything He created
- there is beauty in everything He created
- there is <u>value</u> in everything He created
- there is <u>variety</u> in everything He created
- **there is <u>order</u> in everything He created** (order through interdependence)

-my challenge to you...

- 1. take this list of unchangeables
- 2. circle all the ones that you question or even resent
- 3. (explain comparative experiences and evil/tragedy)
- 4. pray a Genesis 1 prayer over each unchangeable

For example... (breakthrough from self-loathing)

"God, help me to see the purpose in my personality."

"God help me to see the beauty in my personality."

"God help me to see the <u>value</u> in my personality."

"God help me to see the variety in my personality."

"God help me to see the <u>order</u> in my personality."

-"fallen world" is an oversimplification at best and dangerous at worst!!!!
