-Church's too often get all of this backwards...

We shun the non-Christian because of their lifestyle and accommodate the immorality of others because they are Christians.

Your Final Feeling

-2 Corinthians 2:4

-(all the emotions we feel...)

-<mark>Until we get to and settle into a place of sorrow, we aren't ready to</mark> initiate Church Discipline. -Ephesians 4:30 (can't be in step with the HS until you are aligned with...)

-Exodus 32:10-14 (God isn't being human...example of Imago Dei!)

Your Greatest Goal

-retribution or remediation? (Expositor's Bible Commentary)

-2 Corinthians 2:5-8

-Galatians 6:1-5 (this is Paul too!)

-2 Corinthians 5:16-21

-<mark>The best indication of your Church Discipline goal is your prayer about</mark> <mark>the person in question and the situation at hand.</mark>

-Psalm 109:6-13 (means you ain't ready yet!)

Your First Step

-1 Corinthians 5:4-5

-<mark>Any application of a verse that is in direct contradiction of another</mark> Biblical text is never an application God intended.

-Matthew 18:15-17

- Don't be in a hurry
- Win a friend not an argument
- Protect privacy
- A bad attitude undermines right standing
