-read from The Story

- Explain why Sabbath is mentioned
- They had spices, not a change of clothes
- Matthew 17:22-23 (the promise)
- Explain how stone was engineered
- Matthew 16:3 (ref)

-<mark>There are times in our lives when God compels us to move towards the</mark> improbable!

>"I'm so glad God is never going to ask us to do that!"

>"Well Fred, I think it's going to take a miracle for this church to make it."

-The stone wasn't rolled away so Jesus could get out...it was so they could get in!

-Whatever you feel compelled to move towards, it isn't about your inevitable success or comfort but rather building a testimony that will point others to Jesus!

<mark>Opened Eyes</mark>

-read from The Story

- "our women" (joke here...) means they were close to Jesus
- prophet (cultural context), powerful in word and deed (compare to OT which is why we may forget His ministry was normalized)
- listen to what they had been told that morning!
- Why wouldn't they have stayed around if only out of curiosity?

-<mark>Are you willing to walk with people who challenge your ideas and conclusions?</mark>

-Acts 15:36-41 (ref Paul and Barnabas' argument)

-2000 years later we still suffer from the same problem, **allowing** conflict to fracture relationships instead of building them!

-Luke 24:31 (Emmaus reference again)

-(talk about small group Wednesday and Peter with sword...)

-Holy Spirit on Thursday: "So is the angry mob!"

-The angry mob in Gethsemane was so deceived by it's own echo chamber that they couldn't recognize God in front of them! **(preach here some)**
