Before and After

-If you don't have solid beliefs about what happened before Genesis and will happen after Revelation, you might misunderstand much of what happens in between.

-(explain your before Genesis beliefs)

-(explain your after Revelation beliefs)

(use phrase "everyone who chooses to give themselves over to his deception...")_

-My "before and after" beliefs build a context for understanding everything that occurs from Genesis to Revelation...especially my understanding of my ultimate enemy, Satan.

-Who are my scary movie people? (What is your favorite?)

-(tell story of going to see The Sixth Sense in 1999 at the Bryd Theater)

Satan

-<mark>Page 353 – "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely</mark> human concerns."

- Jesus is just now speaking clearly with the disciples what is to come
- Peter pulls Jesus aside to correct him
- "Get behind me Satan"
- Satan is there/supernatural needed to see him/2 Kings 6
- Risk of being overly attached to the earthly existence...leverage for Satan just like it is for Peter in this moment

-<mark>Page 355 – "They were overwhelmed with wonder and ran to greet</mark> Him."

- Are you enthusiastic about Jesus?
- (food, buying and selling stuff, the art of film...how about you?)
- But are you enthusiastic about Jesus?
- The more time you spend expressing your enthusiasm about Jesus, the less likely you'll be distracted by the "shiny object" Satan dangles... (Christianity is an adventure, not a task!!)

-Page 358 – "...before Abraham was born, I AM!"

- Jesus claimed to be God...we just miss it because it's uniquely Jewish.
- Their culture always believed in the Messiah...they just didn't realize God Himself was going to come!
- Is it possible that God Himself is at work in your situation but because it's so different than what you expected, you are believing Satan's lie that you are forgotten!

-Page 359 – "Let us also go, that we may die with him."

- I think the disciples here are demonstrating incredible courage.
- Matthew 26:56 (they all fled)
- Never forget that when we fail, grace offers us a way home!
- I'm not so sure Peter and Judas were very different...except that Peter always chose the path of grace to come back to Jesus.
- How about you? Satan is going to get the upper hand on occasion...does he have the upper hand now?
