# We are born flawed.

-Psalm 51:5

-Does the idea that we are born into sin come from a God who is unfair? Are His standards just too high?

-The idea that we are born into sin is actually God loving us enough to point out our condition. (joke about real friends tell you when...)

# -<mark>Genesis 1:11</mark>

>(explain principle here that is established, "from which they came")

>So if I asked: "When a man and a woman have a baby, will they have puppies or kittens?"

>Romans 5:12

-"from which they came" is not just a biological principle...it is also a spiritual principle.

>Genesis 3:23-24

>All of humanity is born into the world in a state of being separated from God and like Adam and Eve, with a human nature that is naturally selfish.

## Flawed people sin.

-James 4:17 (omission)

-James 1:14-15 (commission)

-1 John 5:17 (venial vs. mortal)

-Romans 13:8-14 & Romans 14 (morality, conscience, and liberty)

-Tonight's message is not about trying to convince you of the Bible's boundaries regarding right and wrong. Tonight's message is asking you to agree with the Bible's conclusion there is at least some right and some wrong and that we have all missed the mark at some point.

>Luke 5:5-8 (explain "miss the mark" being an archery term)

>Every person here, every person who has ever lived, every person who will ever live...has or will miss the mark!

## <mark>Sin falls short.</mark>

-Romans 3:23 (NASB)

-(show tonight's chart)

-Maybe you are here tonight and you would say, <mark>"Fred, I agree that we are all born with a selfish human nature, and that we have all missed the mark at some point and will likely miss the mark again. But what difference does it make?"</mark>

-The second half of Romans 3:23 is saying to us that because of our sin, we are relationally incompatible with God.

>This is a problem for us because our greatest need is to know God and to be known by Him!

-2 Corinthians 5:21

-John 1:14 (Bible constantly comparing our imperfection to their perfection)

-John 1:12

-This is the point where we wade out into the waters of the unknown...

>Dr. Vega telling his son..."We can know enough..." (joke about plantains in Heaven at the other end of the table may take me 100 years to walk there...LOL!)
