Stranded

-(tell the story of being stuck in the desert & show pic)

- -That feeling of being stranded...
 - Helpless
 - Isolated
 - Vulnerable
 - Frustrated
- -Some of you feel that now...on the inside...and you can't figure out why
 - You love your spouse
 - There isn't anything you wouldn't do for your children
 - You work hard at your job
 - You give to others in need
 - You're a neighbor people know they can call on for help
 - You are a loyal friend
 - You're a faithful family member to your parents and siblings
 - You are a good and moral person

-You can't satisfy a Heavenly hunger with an earthly table.

-From the moment you and I were born into this world, our deepest need has always been to know God and to be known by Him.

-Luke 2:14 (KJV)

- -This need for intimacy with God is THE PEACE that the angels were talking about at Jesus' birth!
- -Matthew 13:44-46 (it's the treasure...it's the pearl)
 - We don't deserve it...
 - We can't earn it...
 - We aren't entitled to it...
 - And unlike the parable, we CAN'T buy it! (there is a price)
 - AND we are stranded in this life without it!

-Because of Jesus' goodwill toward us there is hope!
