Recap - Sin and Forgiveness

- -We have a sin problem, regardless of where He puts us, regardless of how many chances He gives us, regardless of how many rules He teaches us. But there's hope, because God has a grace promise for our sin problem.

Introduction - Heaven to Earth

-Matthew chapters 1-2, Luke chapters 1-2, and John 1:1-14 (Mark omits)

- -Isaiah 7:14 (ref)
- -Isaiah 53 (ref)
- -From the moment of Jesus birth, even the circumstances leading up to His birth...every moment fulfilled one of the 60 major prophecies found in the Old Testament.
- -Professor Peter Stoner, Science Speaks

The probability that Jesus of Nazareth could have fulfilled <u>even eight</u> of the 60 major prophecies would be only 1 in 10¹⁷. That's 1 in 100,000,000,000,000,000.

That probability is the same as if we covered Texas two feet deep with silver dollars and sent a blindfolded person, heading out of Dallas by foot in any direction being able, on their very first attempt, to pick up one specifically marked silver dollar.

-And even though these prophecies began 1,000 years before His birth...they didn't recognize Him.

Heaven to Earth

-John 1:1-5 - the pre-existence of Jesus

-John 1:6-9 - the introduction of Jesus

-John 1:10-11 - the rejection of Jesus

-John 1:12-14 - the grace of Jesus

 - 2. God used it
 - 3. Life required it
