# **Disciples Reaction**

-Why are the disciples so upset?

#### -(show timeline diagram)

-1400 BC to 586 BC (rise and fall of Israel)

-prophets Micah and Isaiah (Isaiah's call 740 BC)

-this idea of Messiah began to form...

-Malachi around 400 BC

-400 years of prophetic silence

-John 1:19-20, 29, 35-37 (reference)

-3 years of living and ministering with Jesus

-John 13:33-36 (let's read it with the emotion Peter actually had!)

-Are you disappointed in Jesus in some way? (journal, prayer, share)

# Your, You, & Ye

-Who is Jesus talking to?

-John 14:1-3 (with tenses in the text) (John was there!)

- Genitive indicating a relationship between the two nouns
- Dative beneficiary
- Accusative direct object of the verb
- Plural more than one (disciples who may felt left out)

-Why is Jesus so precise in His language?

>Because He wants you to hear Him talking directly to you.

>This isn't just their promise it is your promise!

>why He pivots to "ye" at the end...don't disqualify yourself!

-(do the "He sees me" exercise)

# 1<sup>st</sup> Century Jewish Marriage

-What is the imagery Jesus employs here?

-Every disciple there was either married OR had been to MANY weddings!

-(description of Jewish marriage in Jesus' day)

- The Messianic tradition has always been a king...
- Now Jesus is adding the idea of a husband...
- The dowry is His life!
- You still have to say yes...
- We ARE in fact waiting for His return...
- And He IS in fact preparing a home for us...
