Seating the Table

- -The Not Yets (focus on one chair)
 - **John 6:44** (No on can come to me unless...)
 - 1 Corinthians 12:3 (...call Jesus Lord but by the power...)
 - 2 Peter 3:9 (...that none should perish)

-God is at work brining every person to the revelation that they need the forgiveness only Jesus can offer.

-The **biggest mistake** is a focus on <u>where they've been</u>, <u>who they are</u> and <u>where they go</u> ... our "invitation" determines their "invitation" so will you be the draw from John 6:44? (draw or deterrent????)

-The Family (move to the next chair, focus on **RESEMBLING JESUS**)

- John 1:12
- 1 Corinthians 3:2 (milk and not meat, choke before chewing!)
- Hebrews 6:1-3 (there are fundamentals we must move past)

-God is at work bringing every person who has been born into the family of God to becoming more and more like Jesus. (refer back to exclusive...)

-The **biggest mistake** we can make is to get frustrated that they don't know which fork goes with the salad and which one goes with entrée! (joke about plastic sheets under the highchair)

(will we be as patient with people as Jesus is with us?)

-The Mothers and Fathers (move to the next chair) (GIVEAWAY!!!!)

-God is at work bringing every person at the table into a season of life where they are hosting more than they are attending.

-The **biggest mistake** we can make is to <u>become complicit in people's eventual disillusionment with life at the table.</u> (the joy of hosting)

-in the hospitality of the table (welcome here) ("How long have you...?")
