Introduction

- -The Holy Spirit is the POWER...Discipleship is the PROCESS...and Church is the PLACE where it all comes together!!!
- -(explain The Church as "a person" as in Bride of Christ vs. The Church as "a place" as in geographic identity etc. etc.)
- -Apostle Paul had one of the most dramatic conversion experiences in the entire NT... and he devoted his life to what...establishing churches...
- -Look at this list **(NT books...)** exist because Paul devoted his life to establishing local churches, spiritual families...because he understood how vital they were to both the **POWER** and the **PROCESS** to have a **PLACE** to impact people!!

-Church: every entity in the first century that warranted the title "church" had a specific geographic identity, a recognizable organizational structure, an identifiable membership, an agreed to leadership, a weekly corporate worship service, the collection and distribution of financial resources...with its members actively engaged in ministry according to their giftings and callings.

Workers

- -Matthew 9:38
- -Luke 9:57-62... (connect "follow" to My Why your Why and to Do)
- -Luke 14:16-20...same buckets restated...NONE ARE BAD THINGS!!!!

If we don't have a Kingdom work ethic then we are out of step with the character of Christ.

- The Time Bucket...not time, but how you spend it
- The Money Bucket...not money, but how you spend it
- The Emotional Energy Bucket...same...
- Not about neglect...
- Not about demeaning wealth or enjoyment...
- If no room for building the church, out of alignment!

-are you living up to what you believe?

- -Are you making enough room in your time bucket for building your church?
 - Are you present more than you are absent? Is there a ministry where you serve? (pop a balloon, replace with...)
- -Are you making enough room in your money bucket for building your church?
 - Are you tithing? Are you practicing priority percentage giving?
 Are you giving to missions monthly? (pop a balloon...)
- -Are you making enough room in your emotional energy bucket for building your church?
 - Are there people in this room who building you? Are there people in this room you are building? (pop a balloon...)

Encounter, Embrace, Engage

- -Luke 7:18-23
- -Jesus is teaching us that outcomes matter.
 - Say good student...let's see your grades
 - Say good employee...tell me about your productivity
 - Say good husband...let's see your wife's countenance
- -Encounter, Embrace, Engage...these are outcomes for us here at City Life...
- -Are people encountering God's presence? Are people experiencing God as a living presence and an active voice? Is there a sense of growing intimacy between God and people who call City Life home?

- -Are people being inspired to believe that God created them with unique abilities, spiritual gifts, and life experiences to build His church? Are people getting a vision for telling people about the Heaven that awaits us? Are people devoting their lives to an eternal purpose?
